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The Telling Producing Cultural Memory

- We abstract textual elements into our codes and conventions
- Then we reconstruct those abstracted elements into our contemporary context
- Artists tap popular cultural memory by
 - Localizing the story
 - Identifying the characters
 - Characterizing their motives
 - Page layout or scene design
