## **Q** Passages

Q is a hypothetical document, and so it does not really have chapters and verses of its own. Scholars designate passages in Q by giving the chapter: verse designation of Luke's passage, since Luke's version of the sayings is more awkward than Matthew's and is therefore thought to be earlier and closer to the source. The translation below is from the 3<sup>rd</sup> edition of *The Complete Gospels*; page references are given to the fourth edition of *The Complete Gospels* as well.
