Jesus' Message:

The Rule of $\operatorname{\mathsf{God}}$

- Why we think that message is historical
 - It's early (Q, Mark)
 - It's embarrassing (did God's rule arrive?)
 - It's multiply attested
 - · in various sources
 - In various "forms" or types of material (parables, beatitudes, aphorisms, passion narrative)
 - It's therefore expressed in those early oral forms
 - It explains why Jesus was crucified

Jesus' Message: The Rule of God

- This rule is based on earlier Jewish visions of God's rule
 - though it expands table fellowship to include others
 - tax collectors
 - sinners
 - and is not as "fire and brimstone" as John the Baptist's message
- But it's also articulated against Rome's political theology
 - Abba ("father") counters pater patriae
 - Soter (savior) used of Jesus counters emperor s title
 - ° Euangelion (gospel) was emperor s term for his announcements
 - Basilea tou theo (kingdom of God) counters kingdom of Rome
 - Twelve: judges for Israel
