Bring them out to us, so that we may know them." 6 Lot went out of the door to the men, shut the door after him, 7 and said, "I beg you, my brothers, do not act so wickedly. 8 Look, I have two daughters who have not known a man; et me bring them out to you, and do to them as you please; only do nothing to these men, for they have come under the shelter of my roof." 9 But they replied, "Stand back!" And they said, "This fellow came here as an alien and he would play the judge! Now we will deal worse with you than with them." Then they pressed hard against the man Lot, and came near the door to break it down.



The Men of Sodom Had Wives

- Lot marries a woman "from the Jordan plain"; he's a foreigner, and she gains him protection (no wife 13:1; has wife 19:15)
- Abraham liberates not just the men of Sodom and Gomorrah but also "the women and the rest of the people" too (14:16)
- "young men to elders" gather around Lot's door (19:4)
- Lot's two virgin daughters are engaged to two men of Sodom (19:14)

Why are these women ignored when people talk about this story today?

The Story of Sodom

Its "crime" isn't unique

The 8th-century prophet Amos denounces the northern kingdom Israel for its crimes against the covenant with God

¹² I overthrew some of you, as when God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah,

and you were like a brand snatched from the fire; yet you did not return to me, says the Lord.

- Amos 4:11

Its "crime" isn't unique

160 years later, the prophet Jeremiah explains why Jerusalem is about to be destroyed by Babylon in the early 6th century BCE

But in the prophets of Jerusalem I have seen a more shocking thing:

they commit adultery and walk in lies; they strengthen the hands of evildoers,

so that no one turns from wickedness; all of them have become like Sodom to me, and its inhabitants like Gomorrah.

- Jeremiah 23:14

The Story of Sodom

Its "crime" isn't unique

After Jerusalem WAS destroyed by Babylon in 587 BCE, the Judeans were comforted by the prophet.

⁶ For the chastisement of my people has been greater than the punishment of Sodom,

which was overthrown in a moment, though no hand was laid on it.

- Lamentations 4:6

So why WAS Sodom destroyed?

Facing the same Babylonian threat, another prophet denounces the Judeans for their actions.

[God speaking]

⁴⁹This was the guilt of your sister Sodom: she and her daughters had pride, excess of food, and prosperous ease, but did not aid the poor and needy. ⁵⁰They were haughty, and did abominable things before me; therefore I removed them when I saw it. ⁵¹Samaria has not committed half your sins...; because of your sins in which you acted more abominably than they, they are more in the right than you. So be ashamed, you also, and bear your disgrace, for you have made your sisters appear righteous.

So why WAS Sodom destroyed?

In this late 1st-century CE letter attributed to Jesus' brother Jude, the author imagines that the fate of Sodom will also be the fate of false Christian teachers

⁵ Now I desire to remind you, though you are fully informed, that the Lord, who once for all saved a people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed those who did not believe. ⁶ And the angels who did not keep their own position, but left their proper dwelling, he has kept in eternal chains in deepest darkness for the judgment of the great day. ⁷ Likewise, Sodom and Gomorrah and the surrounding cities, which, in the same manner as they, indulged in sexual immorality and pursued unnatural lust, serve as an example by undergoing a punishment of eternal fire.

- Jude 5-7; See also 2 Peter 6, which largely copies Jude

So why WAS Sodom destroyed?

Tertullian is an early church author writing in the third century CE. Here, he is arguing against second marriages, claiming that even the FIRST marriage gives in to lust

Is it not enough for you to have fallen from the highest rank of immaculate virginity to a lower one by marrying? Doubtless you will tumble down still further to a third marriage or a fourth, or maybe even more, after you were not continent (because you married once).... Therefore let us marry daily—and marrying, let us be caught by the Last Day, like Sodom and Gomorrah, by that day when the "Woe!" pronounced on those who are pregnant and nursing shall be fulfilled,* that is, the "Woe!" pronounced on the married and the unchaste, for from marriages come wombs and breasts and babies!
